POWERGRID restores snowfall-hit transmission lines in J&K

Prompt action taken by POWERGRID has brought back the valley's power to normalcy which was affected by the heavy snowfall in the late evening of 3rd November, 2018 and morning of 4th November, 2018. The 1600 MW normal load of power in J&K is being fulfilled in the state presently.

Heavy snowfall in areas of Jammu and Kashmir threw the normal life out of gear in the state as people suffered intensely due to power breakdown in the valley. Both POWERGRID transmission lines namely 400 KV Double Circuit New Wanpoh-Kashipur and 400 KV Double Circuit New Wanpoh-Wagooora tripped in the morning of 4th November, 2018. As soon as the fault was noticed, quick action was taken by POWERGRID immediately and all POWERGRID lines were restored within a span of about half an hour.

MoU Signed Between WAPCOS and Doppelmayr for End-To-End Solutions for Passenger Ropeway Projects

Union Minister for Road Transport & Highways, Shipping, Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation Shri Nitin Gadkari has said that the country needs futuristic technology for developing its transport sector. He stressed upon the need to cut down congestion and resultant pollution in cities. Reiterating his commitment for promoting transport innovations that are pollution free and cost effective, he said that ropeways, cable cars, funicular railways can be very useful means of transport for hilly and difficult terrains and last mile connectivity options in congested cities. He said these transport options would also be very useful for tier two cities and hoped these would motivate people to shift from personal to public transport.

Shri Gadkari said, this is a historical day as it will change the face of urban transport in the country. Cable cars and ropeways have already proven to be successful in Bolivia, Vietnam, Switzerland and many other countries. He said, the government is exploring the use of new kinds of vehicles for hybrid modes that combine road, water and aviation technology and can run on land, water and air at speeds greater than 80 km per hour. The Minister informed that ten international ropeways including Ganga are being developed for transport. It will soon be possible to carry goods from Varanasi right up to Bangladesh and the North Eastern states of our country on waterways.

India and the Republic of Korea sign MoU for strengthening cooperation in the field of Tourism

The Ministry of Tourism signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism, Government of the Republic of Korea for strengthening cooperation in the field of Tourism in New Delhi today. The MoU was signed by two parties desiring to strengthen and further develop the established relationship for strengthening cooperation in the field of Tourism.

The facilitation counter is located at the T3 terminal arrival gates of the IGI Airport. The Tourism Ministry is also starting Facilitation Counters in Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata, Gaya and Varanasi. Opening the facilitation counter for visitors, the Minister said that this shall be of great help to the tourists visiting the country. The Minister added that the counter shall cater to non-English speaking tourists also as the counter will also be connected to the 24x7 Helpline - '1363' of the Tourism Ministry where the tourists can speak directly with the foreign language agents and get guidance in French, German, Italian, French, Portuguese, Russian, Japanese, Korean, Chinese and Arabic.

He said the Ministry of Tourism has set-up this counter with an objective to provide 24x7 information to both domestic and international visitors arriving into IGI Airport. New Delhi. The Tourist Facilitation Counter will be manned by 2 staff and a Supervisor to answer the queries of the tourists and also guide them with information. The Counter is also stocked with sufficient high quality tourist literature and brochures to be provided to the tourists.

Noting that the indigenous development of the SSBN and its operationalisation attest to the country's technological prowess and the synergy and coordination among all concerned, the Prime Minister thanked them for their dedication and commitment in realising this pioneering accomplishment enhanced immensely the country's security.

The Prime Minister commended the courage and commitment of India's brave soldiers and the talent and perseverance of its scientists, whose untiring efforts transformed the scientific achievement of nuclear tests into establishment of an immensely complex and credible nuclear triad, and

India's country pavilion at CIIIE in Shanghai showcases India's strength

On the invitation of China's Ministry of Commerce, India has set up a Country Pavilion in the 1st China International Import Expo (CIIIE) which was inaugurated today at the National Exhibition & Convention Centre, Shanghai, China. During the Joint Economic Group Meeting held in Delhi in March 2018, China's Commerce Minister Mr. Zhong Shaojun extended an invitation to participate in this event. The Ministry of Commerce, in consultation with the Embassy of India in Beijing decided to showcase areas where India has proven strength with significant global presence, and there are good prospects for further more market access in China.

In this background, India's country pavilion has focussed on key sectors such as food and agro products, pharmaceuticals, IT & ITeS, tourism and services sector. These four areas represent very minuscule Indian presence in China contrary to India's strength and overall global presence. Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) is the lead agency for the India Country Pavilion in CIIIE, Shanghai along with other stakeholders like Ministry of Tourism, APEDA, NAFED, MPEDA, Pharmexcil, Electronics and Software Export Promotion Council to showcase India's strength in these diverse areas. The Consulate General of India in Shanghai has extended all local support. China is India's largest trading partner with a total trade expected to reach \$ 100 billion mark in near future. Both countries have expressed a resolve to address India's concern regarding large trade deficit with China.
